

BCRC PHASE III POLICIES

7/1/2020

In accordance with the Gov. Northam's "PHASE THREE EASING OF CERTAIN TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS DUE TO NOVEL CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)," the following mandatory policies are in effect for Broyhill Crest Recreation Club.

All persons entering the facility must read and agree to these policies and the pool user acknowledgement. By signing the membership sign-in book with each pool entrance, all patrons acknowledge these policies and acknowledge that none of the symptoms listed below are present prior to entering the pool.

Pool Capacity

- No more than 75% of the pool capacity will be permitted inside the facility at any time.
- The 75% capacity of the main pool is 129 persons.
- The 75% capacity of the baby pool is 9 persons.
- All patrons (except those from the same household) must remain 10 feet apart during all activities, including while in the pool. The guards will make an announcement reminding patrons of this requirement once each hour. Please respect the social distancing guidelines.
- Patrons may be denied entry if the pool is at capacity. Should this occur, the facility will be emptied at break to allow additional patrons the opportunity to enter the facility.
- All children under age 16 must be accompanied by an adult.

Pool Hours

- The pool will be open from 11 AM to 9 PM daily.
- The pool will remain open every day from July 1 through September 7.
- The pool may need to close should state or local guidelines be modified and restrictions on outdoor pools change at any time between now and September 7.
- The pool will remain open for regular operating hours on July 4th although there will no free neighborhood swim.

Membership Duties

- Prior to entry into the facility, all members must self-certify that:
 - They are NOT currently experiencing fever (100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher) or a sense of having a fever.
 - They are NOT currently experiencing a new cough that cannot be attributed to another health condition.
 - They are NOT currently experiencing new shortness of breath that cannot be attributed to another health condition.
 - They are NOT currently experiencing new chills that cannot be attributed to another health condition.

- They are NOT currently experiencing new muscle aches that cannot be attributed to another health condition or specific activity (such as physical exercise).
- They are NOT currently experiencing new sore throat that cannot be attributed to another health condition.
- They have NOT been in contact with anyone that has tested positive for COVID-19 in the past fourteen (14) days.
- Anyone experiencing any of the above symptoms WILL NOT be permitted in the facility.

Pool Operations

- The pool will remain open for 1.5 hours and then be closed for up to 30 minutes for cleaning/sanitizing. Members may remain on grounds but must leave the deck area.
- A long whistle will signify a pool break.
- Face coverings must be worn inside the facility building at all times and outside on deck and grounds when not able to maintain social distancing, which is 10-ft. for outdoor pools.

Deck Furniture

- Members can bring their own chairs should they not feel comfortable using pool supplied furniture.
- Deck furniture is spaced with 10-foot separation per Phase 3 guidelines. Please do not move any of the furniture that has been placed on deck and/or around the grounds.
- All deck furniture must be cleaned and disinfected prior to each use.
- Disinfectant spray bottles and paper towels are provided around the deck for use.

Pool Amenities

- Guest passes are not available due to capacity limits. This policy will be reconsidered after two weeks of operation, at which time guests may be permitted.
- No food, snacks or drinks will be available for purchase.
- Microwaves and refrigerators are not available for member use.
- Grills are available for use but will not be cleaned regularly. Members should clean grills before and after each use. All grilling tools must be provided by each member.
- No pool toys or pool noodles will be provided. Members may bring their own pool toys or pool noodles.
- There will be no parties or pavilion rentals until further notice due to capacity limits.

Grounds

- Patrons agree to use the play sets, court and any other equipment on the grounds at their own risk and in accordance with social distancing guidelines. These commons areas will not be cleaned between uses.
